The Students’ Union will accept electronic Designated Parking Request Forms following the parking lottery **until Friday, September 3th, 2010**. Selections will be completed and a list of the Designated Parking Pass recipients will be made available online at www.ussu.ca and www.usask.ca/consumer_services/parking/ by **4:30 PM, Monday, September 6th, 2010**. If you are not assessed with the highest of needs and do not receive a Designated Parking Pass, you will have the opportunity to purchase a parking spot in the **“Last Chance Sale”** of permits not picked up, which will be held at the Parking Office on a first come, first serve basis. Also, please remember you have the option of using the new Stadium Parkade or parking may be purchased for McEown Park.

Please answer the following questions and attach a brief description of your special need that requires a U of S Students’ Union Designated Parking Pass. You must support your need with appropriate documentation and reasoning. You would not qualify simply because you are a single parent. Example: If you are a single parent, please submit a photocopy of your child’s hospitalization card, details of daycare including a contact person & phone # or the school your child attends. Out of town students will **not** be selected for Designated Parking unless given extraordinary circumstances. They can apply and will be guaranteed parking in Stadium Parkade or McEown Park through the online lottery. McEown Park stalls are “reserved” and “electrified” stalls approximately 10 minutes from campus.
